Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome

We hope you all enjoyed a restful and enjoyable summer holiday. A big welcome back to everyone returning to Pakeman and we extend a very warm welcome to our new children, parents/carers.

The children have settled really well into their new classes and are enjoying both classroom time and playtime. We will keep you informed about what is going on in school through this weekly newsletter, which is sent home with the children. Newsletters can also be found on our school website at:

The School Day—Soft Start

To have the best possible beginning to the school day we have a soft start, which works as follows:

- Breakfast club starts at 8.00am in the Lodge.
- The playground opens at 8.30am and parents/carers are welcome to bring their children and wait with them in the playground from this time.
- The start time for children from Reception to Year 6 is between 8.45am and 9.00am.
- All children in the playground go up to their classrooms independently from 8.45am. Reception class children can be escorted by their parents/carers to the class door.
- Breakfast club children go to their classes at 8.45am.
- There are staff in every class to welcome the children and start them on a range of learning activities ranging from reading, handwriting, spelling, number bonds, times tables and reviewing previous learning.
- Lessons start promptly at 9.00am.
- Please note that any child arriving after 9.00am must report to the school office and is marked late.
- At the end of the school day, Reception children are collected from the covered area in the Reception playground, Yellow and Gold from the football pitch, Green and Pink from the basketball pitch, Orange, Purple and Brown by the mud garden, and Red and Blue by the Lab.

Nursery and 2+ Centre

Please see Nursery and 2+ centre staff about drop-off and collection arrangements.

Playcentre

Playcentre runs from 3.30pm until 6.00pm every evening. The children have lots of fun doing various activities, including art, crafts, games, cooking and drama, and when the weather is good they also play outside.

If you would like your child to attend breakfast club and/or playcentre, you can obtain information about charges and the registration form from the office.

Clubs

We are preparing a programme of exciting extra-curricular clubs for children in Years 1-6. Letters for the clubs will be sent home with the children over the next couple of weeks, starting today. If your child would like to attend any of these clubs, please return the tear-off slips to Layla in the school office as soon as possible. For clubs that attract more applicants than there are places available we will keep waiting lists.

Payment of Fees

Please pay fees for playcentre and music lessons weekly. Clubs must be paid for on each day your child attends the club, or half termly in advance. This is really important as we have to bank the fees weekly. It is also helpful to parents/carers to pay in this way as it prevents back payments from building up.

Concerns

If you have any worries or concerns about your child, please don't hesitate in the first instance to speak to your child's class teacher at the end of the school day, or you can ask in the office to make an appointment with them.

School Meals

The menu for this term is accompanying this newsletter and you will see that there is a 3 week cycle. The menu changes each term. A school meals form must be completed online for each child. We will inform you if you still need to do one and instructions can be obtained from the school office.

School Uniform

Pakeman is a uniform school. Children are <u>expected</u> to wear the correct uniform at all times.

Boys

- A blue Pakeman polo shirt and blue Pakeman sweatshirt with the school logo
- A blue Pakeman fleece with the school logo is also available
- Grey or black trousers (shorts in the summer optional)
- · If shorts are worn, grey or black socks
- Appropriate footwear trainers are fine, but no flip flops or shoes with wheels

Girls

- A blue Pakeman polo shirt and blue Pakeman sweatshirt with the school logo
- A blue Pakeman fleece with the school logo is also available
- · Grey or black skirt or trousers
- If a skirt is worn, grey or black tights or socks
- Grey or black leggings may be worn under a skirt (but not on their own)
- Appropriate footwear trainers are fine, but no flip flops or shoes with wheels
- If a hijab is worn, it must be grey or black
- Blue and white gingham dress in the summer (optional)

All children

- Plain white T-shirt
- · Black Shorts or black tracksuit bottoms
- Trainers/plimsolls
- · Tracksuit for cold weather (optional)
