With just twelve weeks left until the start of the Rio 2016 Olympics, here are some facts you may not know...

- This is the first year that the Olympic Games will be held in a South American country.
- For the first time, a team of refugees will be allowed to compete, under the Olympic flag.
- The Olympic torch started its journey from Olympia in Greece, the birthplace of the Olympics, and it is making its way across the world to reach Rio de Janeiro on August 5th.
- Around 10,500 athletes from 206 countries will compete in this year's Olympic Games.
- The organisers will prepare 60,000 meals a day to feed the athletes!
