






### Reading Challenge



This amazing team of staff have all been growing moustaches this month in order to raise funds for Movember. So far they have raised over **£500** which is amazing.


Movember is a leading charity which aims to change the face of men's health. With money raised, the charity fund health projects all over the world, including mental health, prostate and testicular cancer.
