What are the SATs?

- SATs are the Standardised Assessment Tests that are given to children in year 6 at the end of Key Stage 2.
- They take place over four days Monday 9th May until Thursday 12th May.
- The SATs papers consist of:
- Spelling, punctuation and grammar
- ◊ Reading
- ◊ Maths
