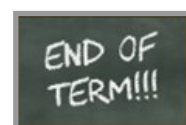

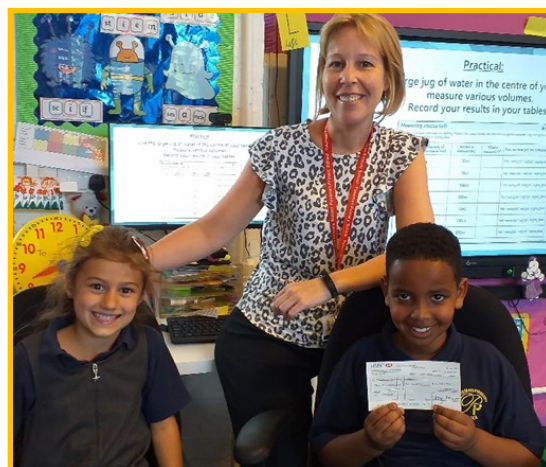

## TastEd at Pakeman

Marcia has been spending time with year 1 and 2 children exploring food, through [TastEd](#) sensory sessions. In their first two sessions, they have enjoyed handling tomatoes and clementines.

It has been exciting watching these children discover new healthy foods. So far, when exploring the foods, they have focussed on the first two senses - sight and touch.
