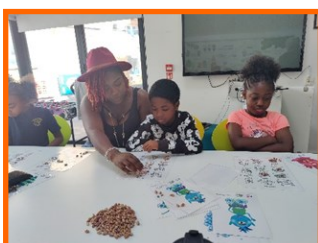
Made of Money Coffee Morning

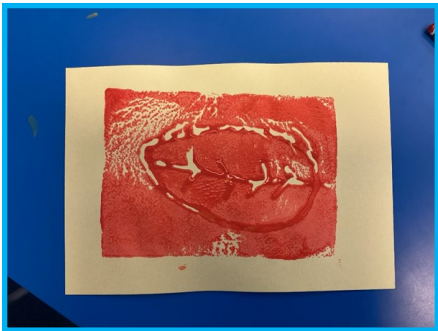

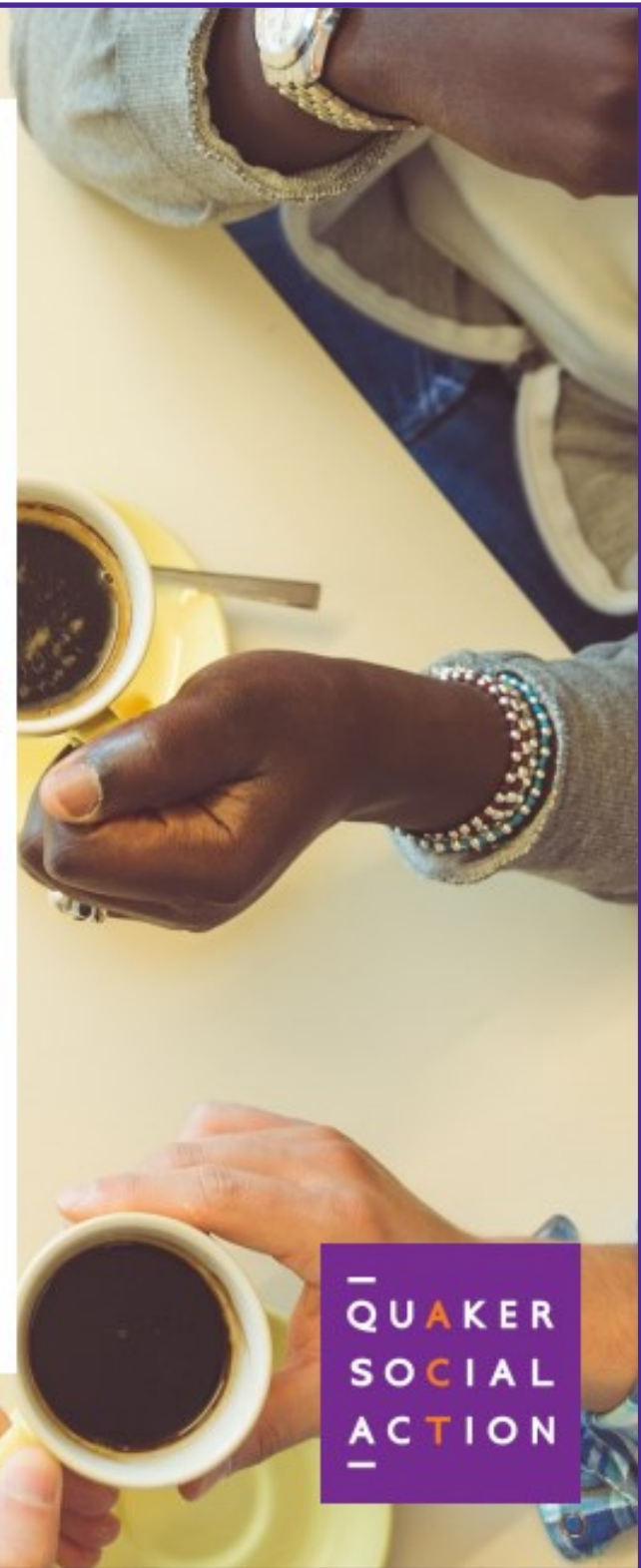
