Healthy Start

Department of Health funded scheme which supports families with children under 4 years and pregnant women to eat well and get the vitamins they need for healthy development.

If you are receiving income support, you may be able to receive a Healthy Start prepaid card.

You could receive £8.50 per week if you have a baby aged under one year, £4.25 per week if you are pregnant, and £4.25 for each child aged under 4 years old. You can use this to buy cow's milk, fresh and frozen vegetables, and infant formula.
