In Islington, ALL pregnant women, women trying to conceive and new




mums with a child under 1 can receive FREE vitamins. Children aged 3 and under can also receive free vitamins for their development.

Last Friday, some of our talented musicians performed to the whole school in a special music concert. The children performed well known songs with a range of instruments including piano, recorder and ukulele.










Phil the Story Teller




