

The Children's Ward at Whittington Hospital is currently a tired, unwelcoming and clinical-looking space. We know that the hospital environment has a big impact on patients' wellbeing, and so we're going to change it.

Using charitable donations, we'll transform the ward into a welcoming and child-friendly space that creates a calming and relaxing atmosphere for our youngest patients.

£50 could help buy sensory toys to reduce anxiety in a distressed child.

£100 could go towards a LED ceiling panel to distract a child when having bloods taken.

FREE VITAMINS



In Islington, ALL pregnant women, women trying to conceive, and new mums with a child under 1 can receive FREE vitamins.

Children aged 3 and under can also receive free vitamins. You do not have to be eligible for the Healthy Start Card to receive your free vitamins.

The vitamin tablets for women contain folic acid and vitamins C and D. The drops for children contain vitamins A, C and D. You can pick up vitamins at all 16 children's centres.
