#### Measles

Measles is a serious illness caused by a very infectious virus. It can be dangerous, especially for babies, young children and pregnant woman.

Measles cases are rising in Islington, with cases being seen in schools and early years settings.

Children who get measles may be hospitalised, and some will suffer life changing complications.

The MMR vaccination is the only way to prevent measles. The MMR vaccine is safe, works well and free for everyone. Everyone needs two doses, ideally with the first dose at 1 year old.
