Electrical Safety Visit to James Selbys

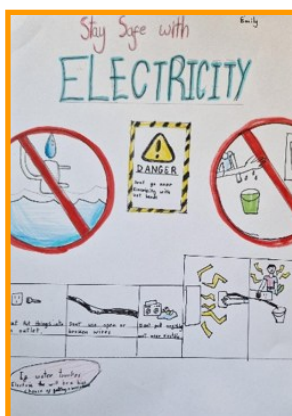
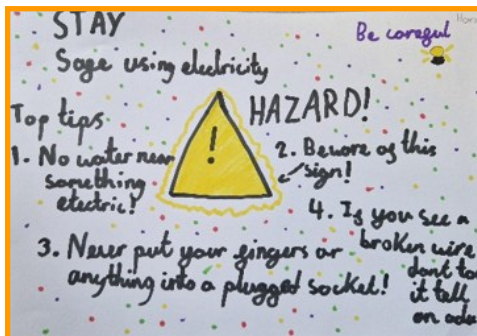

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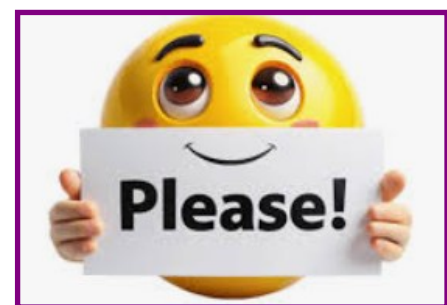

Keeping Children Cool In Hot Weather



1. **Stay Out Of Peak Sun:** To minimise risk, avoid being outside between 11am and 3pm, when the sun is at its strongest.
2. **Dress For the Weather:** Loose, lightweight clothing in breathable fabrics like cotton or linen can help children stay cool.
3. **Keep Hydrated:** Ensure children are getting enough water throughout the day, not just during mealtimes.
4. **Always Use Sun Protection:** Use SPF 30 or higher and apply it 20 minutes before going outside
5. **Sleeping Cooler:** Hot nights can make bedtime especially challenging for young children. Simple changes like a lukewarm bath before bed or switching to a lightweight duvet or sheet can make a difference.
